Oral Health Screening Camp at NCC Bhawan

The Department of Public Health Dentistry, Buddha Institute of Dental Sciences and Hospital, Patna successfully organized an oral health screening and awareness camp for NCC military training students at NCC Bhawan under the Bihar Medical Company on 21st April, 2026.

A total of 350 NCC cadets were screened during the camp. The initiative aimed to assess the oral health status of the cadets and to create awareness about the importance of maintaining good oral hygiene.

In addition to the screening, an interactive health education session was conducted. The cadets were informed about proper oral hygiene practices, causes and prevention of common dental diseases, and the role of diet in maintaining oral health. A live demonstration of the correct tooth brushing technique was also carried out to encourage effective daily oral care practices.

The Department of Public Health Dentistry team was felicitated by Lieutenant Colonel Gerry Matthew for successfully conducting oral screening of 350 cadets in a single day.

This initiative contributed significantly to the early detection of oral health problems and reinforced the importance of preventive dental care among the participants.
